***Saturday Evening, May 10, 2025***

Period dress of the 1850s encouraged, but not required

Known as one of the oldest buildings in Noble County, the tavern was built by Richard

Stone in 1839. They operated the large tavern as a wayside inn until about the time of the Civil War. The building then became a private home, and later was used as a storage area and barn.

The tavern was restored to its present state after many years of being unoccupied and falling into ruin.

Absolutely everything used to repair the tavern (all the furnishings, labor and the building materials) were donated. This historic building continues to be cared for by the dedicated members of the Stone's Trace Historical Society.
